SCHOOL COUNCIL MATTERS

With the main focus on school re-opening plans, we are awaiting direction from the board regarding the functioning of School Councils - including elections, school committees, communication, community support, and fundraising.

Zoom for School Councils

To facilitate the operation of School Councils, the PCEO (Parent & Community Engagement Office) has secured Zoom accounts for every School Council to use. Councils will access this through their TDSB School Council email accounts. Protocols are expected soon.

School Messenger for School Councils

School Messenger is a web-based communication tool that enables the School Council Chair(s) to send one-way communications to the parents/guardians of their school community using the same data base that principals use to broadcast to the school community. Council Chairs have access to School Messenger through their TDSB School Council email account. This launches in September. More information to come.
