PIAC - ADVOCATING FOR YOU

Response to Racism

Like School Councils, PIAC's mandate is outlined in Regulation 612, PIAC's purpose is to advise the Board & Ministry on Parent Engagement, and support School Councils in order to improve student achievement and well-being.

PIAC recently passed a motion in response to incidents of racism in the Parkdale community, asking the TDSB for more action & accountability around acts of racism.

- The Board support "hot" ward zone schools in their School Improvement Plan Equity goals
- That PIAC and the Board of Trustees advocate to the Ontario College of Teachers, Elementary Teachers' Federation of Ontario and the Ontario Secondary Schools Teachers' Federation, and to the Minister of Education to affirm a zero tolerance stance
- The Board convene a task force with representation from Community Advisory Committees, School Councils and parents of the impacted schools
- The Board provide routine disclosure on their website of racist incidents, actions and outcomes


