# SCHOOL COUNCIL BYLAWS

### Easy to Use TDSB Template - Discussion Document Ready

Every School Council is required to have specific bylaws (<u>0. Reg. 612</u>). To ensure alignment of School Council bylaws to Regulation 612 and board policy, the PCEO has prepared a bylaw template for TDSB School Councils to follow. It includes the 3 required bylaws as well as some recommended options.

Download the <u>Discussion Document</u> for your council to select from and, after school community consultation, complete the simple form with your choices and set of bylaws returned. For all councils, whether or you have existing bylaws!

#### Timelines:

- Review the revised PDF Discussion document
- Share with your School Council to develop &/or approve bylaws draft
- Consult on draft bylaws
  with parents/caregivers
- Submit the bylaws template to the PCEO by October 22, 2022
  - Approve your School Council Bylaws by November 25, 2022.

# **DE-STREAMING HIGH SCHOOL COURSES**

In September 2021, the province took the first step to de-stream Grade 9 with a new single mathematics curriculum, no longer provided in two streams of Applied and Academic. In the Fall of 2022, all grade 9 courses will be de-streamed.

As part of the Board's <u>Multi-Year Strategic</u> <u>Plan</u>, the TDSB is working over three years to support the majority of students to study Academic courses for Grades 9 & 10.

Research shows that students in an Academic program of study generally experience more positive outcomes.
