

PARENT ENGAGEMENT: COMMUNICATION

Parent engagement is challenging for school administrators, educators, and parents alike. However research clearly supports a role for parent/family engagement in improving student attendance, love of school, learning, academic achievement/success, and well-being. Parent engagement is more than just pot lucks and movie nights. Parents make a difference!

Good communication underpins effective parent engagement. Try these communication approaches:

- -Parent/Child: Communicate your expectations for your child, show interest in your child's interests, value learning and model successful learning behaviours (put in time and effort, communicate effectively, understand your learning strengths and weaknesses), be specific in praise, establish learning and well-being routines, initiate contact with your child's teacher.
- -Parent/Teacher: Ask your child's teacher for positive feedback about your child and their strengths, ask about curriculum content and links to current events so you can support and reinforce your child's learning using real-world events, ask about learning strategies that will help you support your child, and ask about communication methods and timing for keeping parents in the loop! If your schedule permits, ask your child's teacher about volunteering in the classroom.
