Annual Report

Reg. 612 requires School Councils to produce an <u>Annual Report</u> of activities and financials that the Principal shares with the school community. Think of it as your chance to talk about your hard work!

Election Planning

Form a planning committee for the Fall council election to review dates and the process.

School Council Funds & PRO Funds

Make sure you have spent your <u>council funds</u> by the end of June. Ensure accountability of your <u>Fundraising Plan</u> and submit the <u>PRO</u> report if you received a grant.

IT DEVICES FOR REMOTE LEARNING

Device Return







Over 75,000 devices were loaned to TDSB students for remote learning over the course of the 2020-2021 school year. These loaned devices need to be retrieved & returned to schools to support the 2021-2022 school year.

Students attending summer school will not have to return and re-request a device.

All other devices must be returned by the first week of July for cleaning, technical inspection, necessary repairs and data wiping. They will then be redistributed to the schools initially borrowed from.

Renaming of Schools to Celebrate Diversity

The TDSB will form a group to inform the consultation process for the review of policy PO47 and procedure PR592, Naming of Schools and Special Purpose Areas: propose amendments; and provide a proposal for a city-wide review of all TDSB school names by the end of June 2021. This group will be comprised of students, parents/guardians, educators, community members, appropriate qualified experts and individuals involved in anti-racism work.

Ministry Plans Changes to Remote Learning

The Ministry of Education is proposing dramatic changes to remote learning, including a full-time, permanent option for all grades by September 2021. This could take public education to private providers, with no research or consultation.
