SCHOOL COUNCIL BYLAWS

New Council Bylaw Template coming soon!

Ontario Regulation 612 requires that each School Council develop a set of Bylaws (formal document that defines the standards & principles of an organization).

To ensure alignment of council bylaws to the Regulation and board policy, the TDSB has collaborated with PIAC and parents/caregivers to revise the Board Bylaw Template. This template is expected to be available in November.

Whether or not your School Council already has bylaws, you will need to adopt the mandatory sections of the template. There are 3 required bylaws (Elections, Conflict of Interest, Filling Vacancies, and Conflict Resolution) but your council may choose to have more and include them along with these mandatory sections.

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLANNING

The TDSB is working on guidelines for improved parent involvement in the School Improvement process (SIP).

The 2021/22 proposed <u>Interim Expectations</u> will focus on: explaining the school improvement process and the value of family involvement in it. Principals will seek input on SIP goals with the School Council and share School Data with parents on Wellbeing, Equity, and Achievement.
