School Councils can use a variety of methods to reach out to their families. The TDSB aspires to provide technology tools to support School Councils.

TDSB School Council Email Accounts

The TDSB has established transferable School Council email accounts for School Council Chair(s).

This email can be activated at any time by your Principal and is re-activated annually with a new password, allowing for your address to pass seamlessly from one Chair to the next. You should use this account even if your council has an established external email. (You can forward messages from the TDSB account to any existing email.)

Among other things, the TDSB email account enables the council Chair(s) to receive valuable School Council-related information from the Board and PIAC, and also gives you access to posted grant opportunities.

School Council Messenger

School Messenger is a web-based communication tool that will provide the ability for the School Council Chair(s) to communicate with the parents/guardians of their school community similar to the way school Principals broadcast to their communities today.
