Prepare for a Successful School Council - Form an Election Committee

Now is the time you may want to form an Election Planning Committee for the Fall election. Members of this committee could include the Principal, parents not running for election, teaching & support staff, and, in secondary schools, students. The role of the Planning Committee is to plan and hold transparent elections for membership of parents/guardians, teachers and support staff representatives.



Election Facts

- ➤ Elections must be held within 30 days from the first school day in September
- ➤ Principal notifies parent community 14 days before the election
- > Elections are for the number of parent members outlined in your bylaws
- >Officers are then selected from the elected parent members
