

The TDSB is committed to delivering an inclusive, and culturally-responsive mathematics education. This commitment is part of their <u>Math Achievement Action Plan</u>.

The Math Action Plan details the key focus areas for ongoing professional learning and practice and outlines classroom and school practices for how school teams and the system will support their development and implementation.

CORE FRENCH RESOURCES

TDSB has new Core French resources to support culturally relevant and responsive teaching to meet student needs.

More than 90,000 students at the TDSB are taking Core French in grades 4-12. The program is mandatory from grade 4-8 for all students not in French immersion/extended programs. A minimum of one secondary credit is required to graduate with the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).
