What is Parent Engagement and Why does it Matter?

Parent Engagement is more than coming out to School Council. It is more than participating in the school's parent agenda. It is the relationship between home and school that supports and improves student outcomes.

Research shows when parents are engaged:

- students perform better academically, are more motivated, and experience more social and emotional well-being.
- parents experience a greater sense of empowerment and belonging in the school.
- teachers and principals benefit from a sense of support, reduced stress, and enhanced job satisfaction.

When families are part of a respectful relationship with their school and learning is supported at home, students thrive.

How can School Councils support Parent Engagement?

Get to know who your parent community is and provide the supports that they need for student success.

Build relationships between home and school with community events that foster understanding between staff and families.
