New Tools for Parent Engagement in the SIP

O. Reg 613 from the Ministry of Education, requires Principals to seek input from School Councils in crafting and executing the School Improvement Process (SIP). Collaborating with their Principal, School Councils can devise efficient approaches to:

- Gather input from parents/caregivers and;
- incorporate this feedback into the SIP procedure.

At the TDSB, the SIP must align with the goals and values of the <u>Multi-year Strategic Plan</u> (MYSP). SIP goals follow 4 themes grounded in Equity and Truth & Reconciliation:

Belonging, Thriving, Achieving and Revitalization

Transparency of School Funds

Access to school financial information is inconsistently reported to School Councils and parents/caregivers. To support better accountability, PIAC passed a motion recommending that the Board improve transparency and reporting around 5 specific areas involving School Generated Funds (fundraised money) and school budgets.

- Clarification of School Generated Funds
- School reporting of School Generated funds
- Principal consultation with School Council on the school's budget (Reg. 612)
- Model Schools & Nutrition funding
- School staff financial training to support School Councils



TDSB senior staff responded to our recommendation with a <u>point by point presentation</u>, outlining the definitions, processes and expectations of school staff and School Councils around financial accountability.
