School Staffing Allocations

This time of year, Principals will be getting school staffing numbers for next year. Projected student enrolment determines the staff allocation numbers your school is expected to get. TDSB parents/caregivers should be engaged in the staffing process, helping schools prepare classroom models for the following school year.

Schedule a discussion at your next School Council meeting to discuss the impact on next year's classes, course availability, and how you can be involved in the elementary Staffing Model development.

Elementary

- Development of possible classroom models
- Final model discussed and reviewed with the School Council, prior to forwarding to the Superintendent for approval

Secondary

- Staffing is more of an information sharing piece
- School Council can review and understand the staff allocation numbers and projected enrolment
- possible impacts on course availability

SCHOOL GENERATED FUNDS

What are School Generated Funds?

Funds raised by School Councils and by school staff are both considered School Generated Funds. This broad category includes money fundraised for the school, as well as funds collected from things like field trips, student fees and vending machines.

The principal is ultimately responsible for all fundraising activities conducted in the name of the school. They are required to report to the Board on the school's School Generated Funds as part of the PSAB requirements. These funds are held in a separate, dedicated school account.

School Councils are required to report on funds they raise to the Principal and Principals are required to report on School Generated Funds to School Councils. This can be part of the school Budget Committee or budget discussion at council meetings. Ask your principal about your school budget.

Every February a School Generated Funds report (including balance by school) is presented publicly to the [TDSB Finance, Budget, and Enrolment Committee \(FBEC\)](#).
