School Council Year-End Activities

Take some time this month to address your council year-end activities.

Evaluation

How did the year go? Did we accomplish our goals? Consider surveying your families for feedback. Don't forget to celebrate your successes!

Annual Report

Reg. 612 requires School Councils to produce an <u>Annual Report</u> of activities and financials that the Principal shares with the school community. Think of it as your chance to talk about your hard work!

Election Planning

Form a planning committee for the <u>Fall council</u> <u>election</u> to review dates and the process. Ensure your elections are inclusive & transparent.

School Council Funds & SCIG

Make sure you have spent your <u>council funds</u> by the end of June. Ensure the accountability of your <u>Fundraising Plan</u> and submit the <u>School Council Innovation Grant</u> report if you received a grant.

School Council Funds



School Councils are issued government funds annually to operate and to promote Parent Engagement. TDSB School Councils receive \$500 (Parent Engagement) + \$1.25 per student (council administration). This money is in your school budget on GL 41500. The spending of these funds is a School Council decision.

Depending on the size of your school, that's \$800 to \$1500! Many schools have still not spent their annual allotments. This money does NOT carry over to next year. **School Council funds must be spent by June 30.**

There's still time! Bring the conversation to your School Council about how you can use this money to benefit your school commmunity.
